MISSION & GOALS



MISSION

The Utah Down Syndrome Foundation's mission is to provide hope to individuals, their families, and the community through support, education, activities, outreach, and advocacy.

GOALS & OBJECTIVES

- <u>Support:</u> Offer support to new and expectant parents who receive a Down syndrome (Ds) diagnosis for their child through UDSF's New Parent Outreach Program.
- <u>Education:</u> Provide essential Ds education through UDSF's website, LowDOWN newsletter, Down to Learn classes, New Parent Breakfasts, Peer to Peer Tool Kits, and Financial Workshops.
- <u>Activities</u>: Implement quarterly activities for UDSF families and monthly activities for adults with Ds to promote connection & friendship.
- <u>Outreach</u>: Design a Medical Outreach Program that provides resources and training to medical professionals when delivering a Ds diagnosis.
- <u>Advocacy:</u> Support Ds research, grants, and community programs that impact Ds.

Impact Analysis

UDSF'S PROGRAMS

PROGRAMS

Between 2019 - 2020, UDSF implemented three new programs, added two new community groups, and designed two new programs for 2021. The following are UDSF's additional accomplishments, advocacy work, and main programs' impact.

<u>Website:</u> In September 2019, UDSF launched its new website, udsf.org, which significantly increased our visibility in the community. This website provides resources to help parents navigate Ds at all stages of their child's life.

<u>Advocacy:</u> In 2019-2020, UDSF worked with the following organizations on projects that advocated for Ds:

- **Utah Dept. of Health:** UDSF consulted on the new Ds section's content on the Dept. of Health's website.
- The University of Utah, College of Nursing: UDSF's CEO served on the advisory board for a series of video vignettes that help parents who receive a Ds diagnosis for their child.
- Primary Children's Hospital: Collaborated with researchers on a research study about vascular health and Ds.
- UDSF Community: Sponsored the video, Project Trey: A Down Syndrome Awareness Video, which received 24K views.
- **GEICO Insurance Co.:** Awarded a free car to a single UDSF mom in need of transportation.











IMPACT OF PROGRAMS

Adults with Ds. In 2019, 143 adults with Ds attended 9 activities in SLC. In 2020, due to COVID, only two in-person activities were held, with 22 in attendance. This program is helping adults with Ds find connection and friendship.

Birthday Club. In 2019, 900 individuals with Ds, and in 2020, 873 individuals with Ds received a birthday card from UDSF with a free ice cream to Cold Stone Creamery.

Community Groups. In 2019, 42 social activities were held with 3,460 participants. In 2020, three in-person and two virtual social events were held, with 950 in attendance. These activities provide outreach and support to UDSF families.

Educational Programs. In the 2019–2020 school year, UDSF taught 12 Kindergarten Kickoff classes with 66 in attendance. In 2019, UDSF sent out 7 Peer Presentation Tool Kits and educated 155 peers about Ds. In 2020, UDSF sent out 8 kits and educated 212 peers. In 2020, 3 new finance workshops educated 180 parents.

New Parent Outreach: In 2019, UDSF delivered 41 Newborn Care Packages. In 2020, UDSF delivered 50 Newborn Care Packages. In 2019, 207 individuals attended quarterly New Parent Breakfasts. In 2020, due to COVID, one in-person breakfast was held and two online, with 90 in attendance.

Between 2019-2020, UDSF provided community outreach activities for 4,575 individuals across UT.

During 2019 & 2020, UDSF educated 543 parents through new parent breakfasts, finance workshops, and Kindergarten Kickoff classes.


FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

REVENUE: In 2019, UDSF's total revenue was \$113,030, and in 2020 it was \$109,191. In 2019 and 2020, UDSF received funding from the following sources to accomplish its mission:

2020 SOURCES OF REVENUE




TRANSPARENCY

- In 2019, UDSF transferred its bookkeeping to an outside accounting firm specializing in nonprofits and keeping a detailed audit trail. This firm also prepares UDSF's annual 990 tax return and payroll.
- In 2020, UDSF was awarded GuideStars's Silver Seal of Transparency.

KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

EXPENDITURES: In 2019, UDSF's total expenses were \$109,757. In 2020 total expenses were \$80,773. In both 2019 and 2020, the majority of UDSF's functional expenses were used for programs. In 2020, less was spent on programs than in 2019 because activities were canceled due to COVID. Administrative expenses increased in 2020 due to the management of new government funding. UDSF introduced new fundraising incentives in 2020, which increased fundraising expenses.


